1. Introduction and Welcome

Cheryl Payne (Chair) (CP) welcomed all in attendance and gave a brief overview of the agenda. With over 300 members of FoSMS in attendance, a formal register of those present and absent was not taken. Attached is a list of those who registered their attendance at the event.

2. Treasurers Report 2017/2018

Natasha Hume (NH) presented the Treasurer's Report (available on the school website). In summary, total funds raised in the 2017/2018 year was £21,139.18 which includes the sports fund of £2,042.72. Most profitable events were the Summer BBQ (£5,786.38), Christmas Fair (£4,112.78) and the Art Fair (£2,088.21). The largest expenditures during the period were the interactive whiteboards and computers (£26,695), lighting/backdrop for the school play (£8,539.40) and classroom furniture (£5,221.80).

3. Appointment of Independent Auditors

NH recommended that Wandsworth Borough Council were appointed as the independent auditors for 2018/2019. This was agreed unanimously.

4. Election of FoSMS Committee Members
