Spent = £6,029

At St Mary's we encourage all pupils to lead healthy, active lives by exposing them to a broad and varied range of activities, roles and responsibilities within sport, through the core and extended curriculum.

Funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - is allocated to primary schools to improve the provision of PE and school sport. We received £14,080 for 2017-2018.
