Have the school now assessed all the children's progress and the implications of the pandemic on their current levels of attainment?

Yes, we have completed a full set of assessments across the school.

Will these assessment findings be shared with parent/carers?

Teachers will share their teacher assessments of where the children are now in their learning with parent/carers at the upcoming progress in learning meetings. Hopefully parents will have received information about these meetings via ParentMail today.

Do you have plans now in place for catch-up based on where every child was expected to be (not where the average benchmark is) before the pandemic and school closures?

Teachers have been working on what is called the recovery curriculum since the start of term, ensuring children are well settled back in school and that they are covering any core curriculum which may have been missed over lockdown. Teachers will be focussing on this throughout the year, ensuring that any curriculum coverage which has been missed is addressed and that pupils revisit and consolidate areas which need extra work. By the end of the year, hopefully sooner, every child will be at the same point they would have been had the pandemic not occurred.


Has the school applied for catch up funding? And if yes, how will this be used to support all the children at the school?

Schools do not need to apply for catch up funding—all schools will be given it by the DfE. We received funding of £4,140 just before half term and more funding will be coming in as the year progresses. We have a clear plan for the funds and will provide further news on this in due course when we have confirmed that we can use the funds in the way that we are hoping.
