TRAVELLING ABROAD THIS SUMMER ?

The government announced that from Monday 17 May, international travel can gradually resume as destinations are added to England's 'green list'. Parent/s should therefore be reminded that people should not travel to 'amber' and 'red' countries, and that strict rules on testing and quarantine remain in place to protect public health and the vaccination programme.

EU SETTLEMENT SCHEME

There is less than one month left to apply to the EU settlement scheme for EU/EEA, swiss nationals and family members to protect their right to live, work and study in the UK.

All EU/EAA or Swiss citizens and their family members need to apply to the EU Settlement Scheme by 30 June 2021 to continue living in the UK. They must do so to protect their existing rights, including the right to access healthcare and benefits or the right to work, to rent a property and to study in the UK.

You need to apply even if you:

- are a child
- have a (blue) Permanent Residence document
- have lived in the UK for many years or are married to a British national
- have children that are British
- are a non-EEA citizen and have an EEA Residence card/ Family Permit

Children need to have a status granted in their own name. In most cases, children can get the same status as their parent/carer.
