#### The Curriculum

Your child will now follow the National Curriculum's Key Stage One programme of study. However, to help cover identified gaps, we will also go over key objectives deemed essential for progression. This will likely take the form of review or catch-up sessions prior to starting any new content for the Year 1 curriculum.

### PE Arrangements

This year your child's PE lessons will take place every **Monday** and **Thursday**. Your child should come to school on these days wearing the St. Mary's PE kit and appropriate shoes. If your child takes part in a school sports club before or after school on a **non-PE** day, they are required to change i.e. sports club before school then bring school uniform to change into and after school bring PE kit to get changed into.

**PLEASE ENSURE YOUR CHILD'S PE KIT (AND SUITABLE FOOTWEAR - TRAINERS FOR OUTDOORS) IS IN SCHOOL ON MONDAYS AND THURSDAYS AND IS LABELLED CLEARLY WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.**

### Home Learning Arrangements


Home Learning will be set on a **Friday** and will be due the following **Wednesday**. It will be set via Microsoft Teams and Mathletics. *Please ensure you/your child has access to Microsoft Teams and are able to meet the deadlines for completion.*

There will be weekly home learning as follows:

- **Spellings:** Spelling cards will be uploaded to Microsoft Teams. Physical copies will be sent home after the first spelling test. Weekly spellings are tested on **Friday**. Please ensure that your child brings their spelling card to school on a **Friday** so that we can mark down their score for you to see how they did and what they might need to work on.
- **Dictation:** Dictation cards are uploaded to Microsoft Teams the week **after** spelling cards and are to be completed by the following Wednesday. The due dates will be written on the cards to help you! The dictation helps us to see what your child has been able to retain and what we might need to go over again so please do not let your child see the card before writing and please leave in any mistakes that your child might make.
- **Grammar:** reinforcement sheets will be uploaded to Microsoft Teams on a Friday to let you know what we have been covering in class. These are for your reference and do not need to be returned.
- **Reading:** It is expected that children will read aloud every night for at least 10 minutes. Inside the front and back covers of the Oxford Reading Tree books, there are useful questions to ask your child to probe their understanding of the text. Please refer to these before, during and after reading together. Reading folders should be brought into school every day to enable us to read with your child. Reading books will be changed on a **Wednesday evening**. We will keep reading folders overnight on a **Wednesday** and they will be returned home every **Thursday** after book change. Could you please ensure that you write in the Reading Journal when your child needs new books, otherwise they won't be changed! Books will be changed, if requested, on **WEDNESDAYS ONLY**.
- **Maths:** This will be set on **Friday** via Mathletics. Your child will be set a task on Mathletics which should be completed by the following **Wednesday**. Login details should be stapled to your child's Reading Record Book. We will practice using Mathletics in school to help the children to get the hang of it. Hopefully they will be able to teach you! Optional Maths worksheets will be uploaded to Microsoft Teams on a Friday. These will show you what we have been working on and can be used for extra practice if wanted/needed. They do not need to be returned.

### Communication

If you have any queries about the daily routine or what your child is learning, or to inform us of other matters relating to your child (e.g. if your child is being collected by someone who does not usually collect them), then do not hesitate to get in touch with any member of the Year 1 team. As always, the best way to do this is through the use of your child's PACT e-mail. The PACT e-mail is a great tool for communication between home and school, so please do not hesitate to use it.
