The Curriculum

PE Arrangements

This year your child's PE lessons will take place every **Monday** and **Wednesday**. Your child can attend school on these days wearing the St. Mary's PE kit. If your child takes part in a school sports club before or after school on a **non**-PE day, they are required to

change i.e. sports club before school then bring school uniform to change into and after school bring PE kit to get changed into.

Home Learning

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In Year 5, all children will be given three sets of home learning tasks to complete each week - Maths/English/Guided Reading. As the year progresses and the children settle, we will be adding to this.

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We advise children to spend no more than 40 minutes on each piece of main home learning and to let us know whether they found it too complicated or too easy at the end of the assignment. We expect all of Year 5 children to complete their home learning independently but it would be beneficial for them to have it checked over for accurate punctuation, accurate calculations and neatness before it is handed in. Please comment if you have had to help significantly. If for any reason your child is unable to complete their home learning that week, please send a PACT email explaining why this is the case. If children need help or support with their home learning, they should let the class teacher know as soon as possible.

Weekly spelling and times tables tests will also be given. In addition to spelling accurately, children are expected to be able to use the weekly words in context and apply the focus spelling rule to other unfamiliar words.

Home learning is structured as follows:

Home Learning

Maths: Set on Friday via Microsoft Teams and should be handed in remotely the following Wednesday. We will also set a few Mathletics task each week which should also be completed by the following Wednesday.

English: Set on Friday via Microsoft Teams, to be handed in remotely the following Wednesday.

Guided Reading: Reading and task to be completed.

Independent Reading: Daily for at least 15 minutes each evening.

Spellings: Word lists given at the start of the term. Tested on Friday. The Children should also write each spelling word into a sentence and attach it to their English home learning assignment which they will upload to Teams.

Times Tables: Tested on Friday

Home learning will not be set during holidays
