

There is a fair bit of extra information coming home with In Touch this week, amongst which are two fliers, one on Measles and the other the MMR vaccine which we have been asked to circulate by the local authority along with the following:

We are urging all parents to check that their children are fully vaccinated with 2 MMR doses, which gives 99% life-long protection, by checking their red book or with their GP practice. Anyone not up-to-date should make an appointment with their GP to receive vaccination as soon as possible. This is especially important if travelling overseas over the summer holidays.

Measles is highly contagious and can lead to complications such as ear infections, pneumonia, and inflammation of the brain which require hospitalisation and on rare occasions can lead to long term disability or death. Anyone with symptoms that could be measles is advised to stay at home and phone their GP or NHS 111 for advice, rather than visiting the surgery or A&E, to prevent the illness spreading further. Please continue to be vigilant around family health as we approach winter. Parents in Year Two have had a letter today about a case of Invasive Group A Stretococcal Infection (IGAS) in the class and we ask all parents to be vigilant for the symptoms of IGAS and related conditions. An additional fact sheet on IGAS is attached for information. If you have any queries or concerns relating to any health issue then please contact 111 or your local GP.

When dropping off children at school in the morning we remind all families that children should be dropped at the gate directly on Felsham Road. We ask that you keep the walkway between the main gate and the playground gate clear in the morning.

Congratulations to Year Six children who have completed the Cycling Proficiency course over the last two weeks. Feedback from the instructors was very positive. I look forward to awarding children with their certificates in the next Celebration Worship.

Thank you to all of the committee members, class representatives and parent/carers who attended the FoSMS AGM on Tuesday evening. I am very grateful to Ruth and Rochelle for taking on the Co-Chair role and looking forward to working with them. The committee have some exciting events planned for the year ahead.
