



## **Digital Safeguarding.** Made Simple.

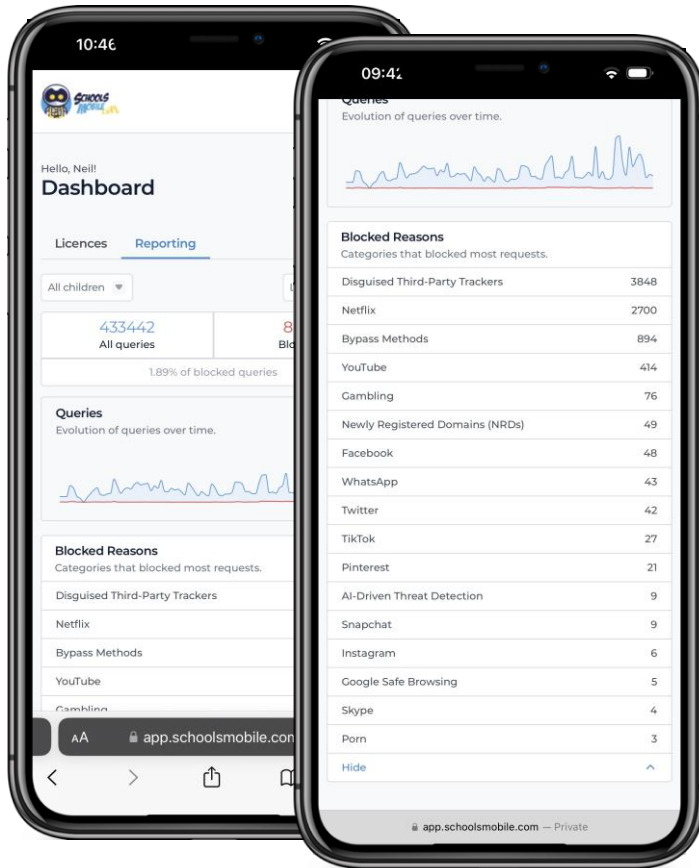
