- Children are eligible for the Nursery class from the school year (1st Sept - 31st August) after their 3rd birthday.
- Parents/carers wishing their child's application to be considered for a Foundation Place **must complete a Supplementary Information Form** (which is obtainable from the St Mary's CE School website or the Admissions Officer at the school).
- Parents/carers who wish to obtain priority for their child's application because of a special social, educational or medical need are advised to send **full details** (please see **Note (e)** in the full Admissions Policy).
- Places will be allocated according to the criteria set out in the St Mary's School Admissions Policy.
- The Nursery class will be made up of two thirds Foundation applicants and one third Open applicants.

Foundation Places:

Two thirds of nursery places will be offered to children whose parent(s)/carer(s) are active in the life and worship of a Christian church [see Notes (b)]. Places will be allocated in the following order of priority:

1. Looked After Children or Previously Looked After Children [see Note (a)]
2. Children of a parent/carers who is a faithful and regular worshipper **and** is active in the life and worship of either St Mary's, All Saints' or St Margaret's churches in Putney.
3. Children of a parent/carers who is a faithful and regular worshipper **and** is active in the life and worship of other Christian churches [see Note (b)]

Within each of the Foundation Place criteria (1, 2 & 3 above), and in case of oversubscription within any criteria, priority will be given **in the following ranked order to:**

- i) Children with a sibling in the main school (Reception - Year 6) on the proposed date of admission
[see Note (c) and NB2 that follows it]
- ii) Children with an exceptional and appropriately evidenced medical or social need for a place at this school [see Note (d)]
- iii) Children living nearest to the school measured in a straight line by Wandsworth Council's Geographical Information System [see Note (e)]

Parents who wish to apply for a Foundation Place must also complete the Supplementary Information Form and **return this to the school** on or before the deadline. Failure to return the Supplementary Information Form will mean that the school cannot consider the application for a Foundation Place. In these circumstances the application will be considered by **strictly applying the criteria for Open Places.**

Open Places:

One third of nursery places will be offered to children irrespective of their religious background. Where there are more applicants than places available places will be allocated in the following order of priority:

1. Looked After Children or Previously Looked After Children [see Note (a)]
2. Children with a sibling in the main school (Reception - Year 6) on the proposed date of admission
[see Note (c)]
3. Children with an exceptional and appropriately evidenced medical or social need for a place at this school [see Note (d)]
4. Children of qualified teachers (QTS) and teaching assistants employed by the school who have worked at St Mary's for more than two years prior to the date of application. Such priority will be limited to one place per year group admitted from the 2018/19 school year onwards [see Note (f)].
5. Children living nearest to the school measured in a straight line by Wandsworth Council's Geographical Information System [see Note (e)]

Within each of the Open Place criteria (1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 above), and in case of oversubscription at any criteria, priority will be given **in the following ranked order to:**

- i) Children with an exceptional and appropriately evidenced medical or social need for a place at this school [see Note (d)]
- ii) Children living nearest to the school measured in a straight line by Wandsworth Council's Geographical Information System [see Note (e)]
