Children who have completed their communion classes can take part in the communion meal. A blessing or the choice to stay in your seat is also offered.

Attendance was looking good at the end of last year—we were close to our target of 97%. Thank you to all of you who avoided term time holidays. It would be great if we could make it to 97% this year. Some children have already missed their first few days in school when all of the routines and expectations are established. If they were adults it would be like missing your induction at work and being thrown straight in.
