If your child takes part in a school sports club before or after school on a **non**-PE day, they are required to change i.e. sports club before school then bring school uniform to change into and after school bring PE kit to get changed into.

Home Learning

In Year 5, all children will be given three sets of home learning tasks to complete each week - Maths/English/Guided Reading. As the year progresses and the children settle, we will be adding to this.

We advise children to spend no more than 40 minutes on each piece of main home learning and to let us know whether they found it too complicated or too easy at the end of the assignment. We expect all of Year 5 children to complete their home learning independently. Please comment if you have had to help significantly. If for any reason your child is unable to complete their home learning that week, please send a PACT email explaining why this is the case. If children need help or support with their home learning, they should let the class teacher know as soon as possible.

Weekly spelling and times tables tests will also be given. In addition to spelling accurately, children are expected to be able to use the weekly words in context and apply the focus spelling rule to other unfamiliar words.

Home learning is structured as follows:

Home Learning

Maths: Set on Friday via their home learning books. It will also be available on TEAMS for those who may be absent. The home learning should be handed in by hand, in their books the following Wednesday. We will also set a few Mathletics task each week which are do not have to be completed but are available if parents would like their children to have some extra consolidation. These can also be completed by the following Wednesday.

English: Set on Friday via their home learning books, to be handed in by hand the following Wednesday. This will usually be either a reading comprehension, written task or a grammar task. By the end of the year the children will need to complete tasks in all three areas.

Guided Reading: Reading and task to be completed before their following GR session. **Independent Reading**: Daily for at least 30 minutes each evening.

Spellings: Word lists given at the start of the term. Tested on Friday. Please encourage the children to learn the spelling rule. This will enable them to apply it to other words they are unfamiliar with.

Times Tables: Tested on Friday. Practice sheets will be uploaded to team to enable children to practice regularly.

Communication

If you have any queries about the daily routine or what your child is learning, or perhaps to inform us of other matters relating to your child, then do not hesitate to get in touch with any member of the Year 5 team. As always, the best way to do this is through the use of your child's PACT. The PACT e-mail is a great tool for communication between home and school, so please do not hesitate in using it.
