A very happy new year to you! We hope you have all had a wonderful Christmas and that 2026 is a positive year for you and your family. Thank you all for your generosity to the staff team at the end of last term—it was hugely appreciated.

Just a quick reminder about snacks and packed lunches. Children are permitted to bring snacks to school to eat at break times. Please remember that we are a nut free school and we ask that children bring only fresh or dried fruit and/or vegetable sticks as snacks. If your child has a packed lunch then we recommend the following:

- A good portion of starchy food, e.g. wholegrain roll, wraps or pitta pockets, pasta or rice.
- A portion of lean meat, fish, egg, pulses or other non-dairy protein.
- Plenty of fruit and vegetables e.g. apple, satsuma, tomatoes, carrot sticks, small tub of salad etc.
- A portion of semi-skimmed or 1% fat milk or other dairy food, e.g. reduced fat cheese, yoghurt or fromage frais
- A drink e.g. fruit juice, yoghurt drink or a bottle of water

It's been a chilly start to the Spring Term, but all of the children have settled back into routines quickly and are already hard at work. All we need now is for it to get a bit warmer! Hopefully Spring will be on its way soon and we can look forward to brighter, lighter days!
