#### The Curriculum



We will be following the content outlined in the Spring Term.

#### PE Arrangements

PE lessons continue to take place every **Tuesday** and **Thursday**. Your child can attend school on these days wearing the St. Mary's PE kit. If your child takes part in a school sports club before or after school on a **non-PE** day, they are required to change i.e. sports club before school then bring school uniform to change into and after school, bring PE kit to get changed into.

On Tuesdays, this half term, will be Gymnastics. For safety reasons, it is helpful for children to be barefoot for this lesson. They should ideally be wearing shorts for the lesson. This is so that they can use the apparatus in the hall more safely. I have told the children that **they can wear shorts under their jogging bottoms** so they can be warm enough for the rest of the day.





## Home Learning

The majority of home learning will be set in books but is also available via Microsoft Teams. Please ensure your child has access to Microsoft Teams, including knowing their username and password.

There will be weekly home learning as follows:

<b>Home Learning</b>
<b>English:</b> Set on <b>THURSDAY</b> via Microsoft Teams and should be handed in the following <b>TUESDAY</b> . Most English home learning will link with developing writing, such as creative and descriptive writing, acrostic poems, grammar, punctuation and vocabulary tasks. This should take on average 30-45 minutes.
<b>Maths:</b> Set on <b>THURSDAY</b> via Microsoft Teams and should be handed in the following <b>TUESDAY</b> . Most maths home learning will link with the work done in class. This should take on average 30-40 minutes.
<b>Reading:</b> Daily - to be listened to by an adult for at least 10-15 minutes each day - if possible. Children should read their book borrowed from the class book corner, school library, or one from home. - Reading records - A journal entry should be completed at least four times a week. <b>Prizes are awarded to records with four record entries per week.</b>
<b>Spellings:</b> Spelling cards will be shared at the start of each half term showing each week's spellings to learn. These weekly spellings will typically be set on Monday and tested in school on Friday. This half terms sheet is <b>pink</b> to avoid any mix ups.
<b>Times Tables:</b> <i>Please practice regularly</i> - in Year 4 children will be required to learn times tables facts up to 12x12. Additional practice at home is helpful to help children be able to recall facts automatically.
<b>Optional Home learning will not be set during the holidays.</b>
