Dear St Mary's Community,

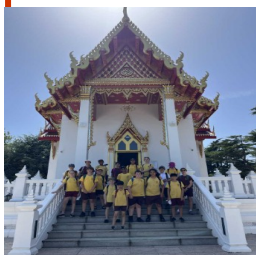
